This document contains a description on how the site: www.life-trialkyl.eu is handled and managed with regard to the processing of personal data belonging to the customers who visit the site or use its services.

The privacy disclosure falls within the scope of art. 13 of legislative decree n° 196/2003 – code concerning personal data protection –and is addressed to those who enter into contact with the online services rendered by Italmatch Chemicals S.p.A. that are accessible through www.life-trialkyl.eu, which is the address of the homepage of the internet website.

The privacy disclosure is inspired by Recommendation n° 2/2001 on the protection of personal data adopted on 17th May 2001 by the European Authorities, in particular by the working party established by article 29 of Directive n° 95/46/CE, and is intended to identify a minimum set of obligations for the collection of personal data on-line, in particular when, how and which information must be provided to individual users when they browse our web pages, independently of the objective of their visit to the website.

Place and principles for the data processing

The data processing procedures related to the web services of this site take place in the premises of Italmatch Chemicals S.p.A. and are implemented only by the internal staff in charge of the treatment or occasionally by some employee in charge of maintenance operations.

The data collected during the use are processed exclusively by authorized subjects, with electronic and non-electronic instruments, for the time needed to reach the purposes for which the data are collected.

With a view to prevent data from being lost, illegally or improperly used, specific safety measures are implemented, aimed at guaranteeing confidentiality and avoiding the illicit access by third parties or non authorized staff, in compliance with law obligations.

Types of processed data

Anonymous browsing data

IT systems and software procedures underlying the functioning of this web site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data that are implicitly transmitted via the use of communication Internet protocols.

These data are not collected to be associated with identified interested individuals, but rather, based on their nature, they could, through processing and associations with data held by third parties, allow the identification of users.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by the users who browse the site, addresses in URI notation (Uniform Resource Identifier) of the required resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the state of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc) and other parameters concerning the operating system and the IT environment of the customer.

These data are used with the only purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and of checking its proper operation. The data could moreover be used for ascertaining liabilities in the event of presumed IT offences that may damage the site.

Data supplied by the user on a voluntary basis

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of emails to addresses indicated on this website shall lead to the acquisition of the email address of the sender, needed in order to respond to the sender's requests, and of any other personal data included in the message text.

The information supplied by the user is utilized by Italmatch Chemicals S.p.A., on behalf of the Partners of the LIFE-Trialkyl project, with the only purpose of collecting data and make customized statistics on the use of the site. The information shall be made available also to the Partners of the project.

Cookies

Cookies are small data files that are transferred to the computer of the user when a web site is visited for the first time. The file contains elements that are capable of unequivocally identifying the computer of the user.

The use of so-called session cookies (that are not persistently stored on the user's computer and disappear when the browser is closed) is strictly confined to the transmission of the data identifying the session (composed of casual numbers generated by the server) needed for a safe and efficient exploration of the site.

Rights of the interested parties
